Charles P. Abulencia, Sr., 83, of Cicero, NY, passed away peacefully with his family at his side on Monday, January 2, 2023. Charlie was born in Syracuse to the late Genaro Pal and Mary Elizabeth (Hamilton) Abulencia. He graduated in 1957 from North Syracuse High School where he was a member of the track team. A long-time member of St. Thomas Episcopal church, he was an acolyte and continued his Episcopal Church membership at St. Matthew's, Liverpool. Charlie retired in 2001 from the P&C Warehouse, where he held many positions throughout his 40 years with the company. He also served the Cicero Volunteer Fire Department with honor, pride, and distinction for 59 years, holding several roles, including Fire Chief.
