With sadness we announce the passing of Chuck (Charles) Jonick from Cicero, NY on Thursday, April 18, 2024.

Chuck served the golf community for over 50 years as professional golf instructor and owner of the Cicero Golf Shop and driving range on Brewerton Road. He passionately assisted his customers - most of whom he could call friends - purchase the perfect golf equipment, learn the fundamentals and courtesies of playing golf, and master the complexities of the golf swing. He taught a countless number of golf lessons to individuals and groups throughout his career. It is hard to go anywhere within 50 miles of the golf shop and not meet someone who had taken a lesson or two from Chuck or who did not know him in some other way. He was a pillar of the local community and cared about everyone he met.

One of the most common observations about Chuck was he never forgot the name or face of anyone he met, no matter how much time had passed. Chuck routinely participated in charity events, donating time and equipment, to contribute to the community in a personal way.

Chuck served in the US Marine Corp Reserve from 1961 to 1966 as a tank driver.

Chuck is survived by his son, Gary; his sister, Joanne; and his brother, Ken and their families. He is also survived by countless friends and acquaintances in the community. He will be remembered by many.
