Charles R. Miller, 93, of North Syracuse, died at Crouse Hospital on August 14.

Charlie grew up in the Valley section of Syracuse and attended Onondaga Valley Academy (graduating class of 1946) and Syracuse University. He served four years in the Navy and was a graduate of the Naval Air Technical Training Program.

Before retiring in 1988, he was employed for 40 years with the General Electric Company, where he held several positions in manufacturing management, primarily in the Cathode Ray Tube Department at Electronics Park in Liverpool. He is a past member of G.E.'s Elfun Society, a community service group founded in 1928.

Charlie was also co-founder and first president of the Central New York Parents Association for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, which advocated for hearing-impaired children and their families. He enjoyed fishing, hiking and woodworking.

He is survived by his three sons: Charles R. (Dolores) of Pierrepont Manor; Craig A. (Heidemarie Carle) of Rensselaerville; and Jeffrey J. of Camillus; four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. Charlie was predeceased by his wife of 38 years, Betty Miller.

Visitation is scheduled for 10 a.m. Friday at the Fergerson Funeral Home, 215 S. Main St., in North Syracuse, followed by a memorial service at 11, the Reverend Glenn Bozak officiating. Burial will follow in Onondaga Valley Cemetery. In Charlie's memory, contributions may be made to the American Lung Assn. or the charity of one's choice.
