Cynthia A. (Hale) Tafel, 75, of North Syracuse passed away on Sunday, October 29th, after an illness. Born in Syracuse to the late James L. and June M. (Hottinger) Hale, she was a graduate of Liverpool High School, Onondaga Community College and Syracuse University.

For the North Syracuse Central School District, she was a special education assistant for one on one learning at Cicero North Syracuse High School.

Music was important to Mrs. Tafel. She was the organist and choir director, first for the First United Methodist Church of East Syracuse and later for Pitcher Hill Community Church where she was a long time member. At CNS, she was accompanist for the women's choir and for many of the stage productions.

She gave private piano lessons. Always an advocate for local opera and theater, she was a summer membership promoter for Syracuse Opera and a promoter and supporter of local theater.

Surviving are her husband of 47 years, Howard F. Tafel; her children, Lee Tafel, Dana Nalls, Jennifer Colton-Sanchez, Susan Manradge and Amanda Tafel; a brother, James P. 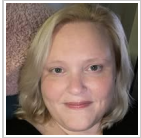

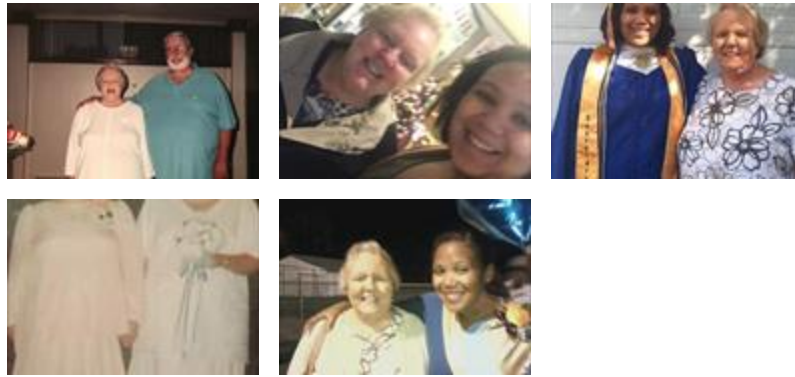
