Donald "Donnie" Mula, 77, of Brewerton passed away at St. Joseph's Hospital after a long illness, Born in Syracuse to the late Dominick Joseph and Filomena Marie (Greco) Mula, he was also predeceased by a sister-in-law, Brenda (Jenner) Falter.

Deacon Mula was a communicant of the Parish of the Divine Mercy where he served, having been ordained a Deacon in 2010.

In 2001, he retired after 35 years with the NYANG, 174th Fighter Wing (now Attack Wing) formerly known as the "Boys from Syracuse". He served in Desert Storm. On the base he was a member of the Rifle and Pistol Team and as a sharpshooter, was invited to Munich, Germany to tryout for the 1972 Olympics.

Originally, Don was a member of the North Syracuse Fire Department, where he had been a Deputy Chief. He joined the Brewerton Fire Department in 1986, became a life member and had served as an Assistant Chief. He was on the softball teams of both fire departments. For the Town of Cicero and the Village of North Syracuse he had served as Fire Marshall.

Donnie was a friend to all, loved talking to people and helping them out. He was someone everyone sought out for help and advise. He was a great Godly man, who was evangelizing to the end.

Venturing into many activities, he played golf, was an artist, especially of portraits and enjoyed boating, fishing, and woodworking.

Surviving are his wife of 37 years, Donna M. (Jenner) Mula; his daughter,
