Donald G. Stoddard, one day short of 75, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, February 10, 2026. Born in Townshend, Vermont, he was one of the fourteen children of Maurice Price and Roberta Faye (Fielder) Stoddard, Sr. He served in the US Air Force from 1978 to 1991 in Korea, England, Albuquerque and in extended service for Operation Desert Shield/Storm.
