Grace Mary “Gracie” Beach, 97, of North Syracuse, passed away on Wednesday, December 24, 2025. Born in Syracuse, she was the daughter of the late Bruno and Jennie (Calabro) Giordano.

Gracie was a Charter Member of NAVAC, the North Syracuse Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary, the Firemen’s Association State of NY (FASNY) Auxiliary and was a communicant of St. Rose of Lima Church, North Syracuse. She was on the crew that delivered the first NAVAC baby. She was often by her husband's side in County Car 2 as he was responding to working fires, feeding the working crews an assortment of pepperoni, cookies, and various snacks. She always was looking out for others, even during her final days at Elderwood in Liverpool.

Predeceased by her husband of 70 years, Richard “Dick” Beach in 2017 and her son, Richard “Rick” Beach in 1990, she is survived by her children, Patricia Chilton (her husband, Donald) and Kenneth Beach. Also surviving are her grandchildren, Joshua Chilton (his wife, Kerrin), Schyler Chilton (her husband, Mark), Dalton Beach, great granddaughter, Parker Chilton as well as several nieces, nephews and lifelong friends that are considered family.
