Hilda E. (Lord) Benjamin, 104, of North Syracuse, passed away on Wednesday, September 24, 2025. Born in Syracuse to the late Edward A. and Hilda (Roebuck) Lord, her siblings were Edward, Eugene, and Dorothy. She graduated in 1939 from Blodgett Vocational High School. In the 1940's, she had worked for Gorke Electric Company and for Ebeling's Pet Centers until her 1983 retirement.

Hilda was a member of St. Thomas Episcopal Church, North Syracuse, where she had served as a church schoolteacher, on the vestry, head usher, a counter, in the choir and was a member of the ECW. Recently, she was a member of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Liverpool.

An active life member for 85 years of the Order of the Eastern Star, State of New York, she was Secretary for over 50 years for BonaFide-Hiawatha-Solvay Chapter, No. 567. She was Worthy Matron of Hiawatha Chapter in 1947 and in 1965, she was District Deputy Grand Matron of the Onondaga District.

Predeceased in 1996 by her husband of 51 years, Harry A. Benjamin, she is survived by her children, Alan E. (Carolyn) Benjamin, David M. (Donna) Benjamin, Keith C. (Debbie) Benjamin and Nancy E. (Joe) Coveney; seven grandchildren; thirteen great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
