Marland P. "Marv" Armstrong, 91, of North Syracuse, passed away at his daughter's home in Arizona. Born in Auburn, he was the son of Floyd and Mildred Armstrong. He graduated from Auburn High School, then joined the Army and served during the Korean war.

Marv worked for General Electric Company starting as a drafting trainee and retired as a drafting manager. Marv was a member and a Commander of North Syracuse American Legion Post 1297 and a life member of VFW Post 3146 in Mattydale, New York. Since 1957 he was a member of the Luther Memorial Lutheran Church.

Marv loved his 50's hot rod with the tractor clutch, classic Fairlane and Mustangs. He also was an avid photographer, league bowler and on GE golf team with his wife.

Marv loved to travel and visited all 50 states, Canada, Costa Rica, Mexico, Australia and New Zealand. He drove through seven countries in western Europe, plus England, Scotland and Ireland. Also visited many Caribbean islands but frequented Aruba over 20 times. He also wintered in Daytona Beach, but after the passing of his wife of 60 years, Ann Armstrong, he visited yearly with his children.

Surviving are his children, Terry Ann (Ken) Simmons of Colorado, Gary (Deborah) Armstrong of Virginia and Candace Lynn (Fred) Cramer of Arizona; two granddaughters, Jacquelyn A. Armstrong of Orlando Fla. and Victoria L. Armstrong of Richmond Va. and several cousins in New York and Virginia.
