Natalie Belik Kozak, 88, of Cicero passed away on Saturday, October 2, 2021 at Crouse Hospital.

Born in Belgrade, Serbia, she immigrated in 1949 and had lived on Onondaga Hill before moving to Cicero in 1989. She graduated from Elmira College and interned at St. Joseph's Hospital.

She began working at Memorial Hospital after completing her national registry (MTASCP). In 1997, she retired from Crouse Hospital as a Registered Laboratory Medical Technologist after 41 years with the hospital.

She was a long time member of St. Mary's Russian Orthodox Church. Her past times included gardening, shared lunches, shopping, knitting and spending summers at her cottage in Clayton.

Mrs. Kozak was predeceased by her husbands, Vasily Turtschin in 1987 and Walerian Kozak, in 1997 and by her daughter, Lydia Tischenko on January 26, 2017. Surviving are her daughter, Irene Sack; son, Andrew (Michelle) Turtschin; son-in-law, Alexander Tischenko; grandchildren, Jacob (Mikayla), Connor, Zachary, Kayla, Michael and Andrew.
