Paul S. Shaver, 86, of North Syracuse passed away on Wednesday, April 27, 2022. Born in Syracuse to the late Roger R. and Sybill (Moeller) Shaver, he graduated from St. Anthony's School. He served in the US Army, graduated in 1962 from LeMoyne College and in 1963 from Syracuse University. He retired from Liverpool High School business education program and was an adjunct professor for SU and OCC.

Paul was a communicant of St. Rose of Lima Church where he was a lector and Eucharistic minister. He was past coordinator of the Syracuse Right to Life Chain and served as treasurer for Syracuse Right to Life.
