Robert “Bob” Finley, 87, formerly of Cicero and Zephyrhills, FL, passed away in Sarasota, FL on Friday, August 12th. Born in Oswegatchie, NY, Bob graduated in 1952 from Heuvelton Central School and in 1957 married classmate, Helen Clark. He attended Clarkson University, was licensed as a NYS Professional Engineer and received his economics degree from Syracuse University.

Bob served in the US Army in Germany from 1958 to 1960 and was recalled from 1961 to 1962 to serve during the Berlin Crisis. During the time of his military service, he was a surveyor on the St. Lawrence Seaway and the Niagara Power Projects. From 1962 until 1994 he worked for Niagara Mohawk, retiring as Senior Project Control Engineer.

Bob was a long time member of Cicero United Methodist Church and the Barbershop Harmony Society and a past leader of Boy Scout Troup 117. Surviving are his wife of 65 years, the former Helen Clark; sons, Michael (Carol) of Bradenton, FL and David (Yinka) of Stoughton, MA; grandchildren, Jordan (Maureen), Eryn (Chris) Hagood and Esme Finley; great grandchildren, Brynn Finley, Amelia Finley and Warren Hagood; sisters, Norma Finley and Katheryn McCamish and several nieces and nephews.
