Robert Louis Sager, 84, of Liverpool, passed away on Thursday, January 28, 2021. Born in Syracuse, raised in Mattydale, he graduated in 1954 from North Syracuse High School where he and his wife of 63 years, Edythe, became sweethearts. Living in the same Liverpool home since 1959, they have traveled extensively, including wintering for 20 years in the St. Petersburg, FL, area with many retired friends. He served in the 108th Air National Guard and was activated during the Berlin Crisis in 1961.

Bob began with Niagara Mohawk in 1967 as chauffeur to the president, later serving in several positions until his retirement in the 1990's. He was a life member of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Lodge No. 2348.
