William A. "Bill" Fowler, 93, of North Syracuse, formerly of Tully, passed away on Friday, October 18th, 2024. Born in Austin, Pennsylvania, to the late Glenn William "Dan" and Doris Pauline "Polly" (Long) Fowler, he was the last surviving of their three sons. In 1987, he retired as Senior Master Sergeant from the 174th NY Air National Guard Tactical Fighter Wing after over 30 years of service, including time spent in Europe during the Berlin Airlift.

Bill had over 20,000 hours as a volunteer at the Veterans' Administration Medical Center Audio and Eye Clinics. He was a lifetime member of the VFW and held local, state and national positions. He was a member of the Military Order of the Cooties (MOC) and of Posts 7290 and 3146. He also was a meat cutter for Smith's, Sweetheart Market and Andy's Big M grocery store.
